The following are two-year goals to be accomplished over the next 2 Fiscal Years, 2019-21.

- This past year we had 33 counties join, one organization, and 8 individuals.

Our goal is to add 6 more counties, to our membership, over the next 2 years. Which counties to be targeted to be determined by Regional VPS and Membership Subcommittee

- In order to strengthen our presence within the State we should work to be more involved in training for IHSS Advisory Committees. In order to do this, with limited funding, we will work towards two-Regional Trainings each fiscal year cooperating with the Host County, with one Regional Training to be held during the Disability Capitol Action Day.

Sacramento Region to start work on beginning in September - Yolo and Sacramento would be good to team up as hosts (Cindy & Janie), Riverside (Kristine), Humboldt to be in October 10, San Bernardino, Santa Clara, Solano (Sandi), Orange/LA to do a joint (Chris/Janet/

We will also provide 4 to 6 webinars using “Go-To-Meeting.”

Webinars could be offered a few times a year (offering them to different parts of the State to keep attendance to a limited number to allow questions). All webinars will first be given to the CICA Executives for education and feedback.

Webinars can be on the Brown Act, AB 1682 and Advisory Committee purposes, recruiting Advisory Committee members, Olmstead (saw where this is offered by other organizations), etc.

It is planned to put webinars together present to CICA and County Representatives looking for comments, as well as offering Q&A and postings as a video and Power Point Presentation on our website to be available.

- Look for sponsors to sponsor webinars! This goes back up to providing advertisement for a sponsor – If a company sponsors a webinar, we would recognize it at the beginning of the Webinar, and at the end. The business logo can be attached to all slides.
