**Goals for FY 2020-22**  
**July 2020**

The following are two-year goals to be accomplished over the next 2 Fiscal Years, 2020-22.

- This past year we had 34 counties join, one organization, and 30 individuals.

Our goal is to add 6 more counties, to our membership, over the next 2 years. Which counties to be targeted to be determined by Regional VPS and Membership Subcommittee

**Ideas to recognize organizations or sponsors:**

**Some suggest organizations to invite membership:**

California Welfare Directors Association, Regional Centers, CARA, National Mental Health Organization, SEIU 2015 (John Roe), CFILC, Kaiser (John provide a contact), PG&E (Do they contribute), Health Care Organizations (Medicals Plans dealing with Medi-Cal), CCI Groups, PASC-LA, Increase involvement of the Unions.

- In order to strengthen our presence within the State we should work to be more involved in training for IHSS Advisory Committees. In order to do this, with limited funding, we will work towards two-Regional Trainings each fiscal year cooperating with the Host County, with one Regional Training to be held during the Disability Capitol Action Day. This is on-going but we need to work on virtual training for Advisory Committees and Groups because of the COVID-19 virus.

We will also provide 4 to 6 webinars using “Zoom.”

Webinars could be offered a few times a year (offering them to different parts of the State to keep attendance to a limited number to allow questions). All webinars will first be given to the CICA Executives for education and feedback.

Webinars can be on the Brown Act, AB 1682 and Advisory Committee purposes, recruiting Advisory Committee members, Olmstead (saw where this is offered by other organizations), etc.

It is planned to put webinars together present to CICA and County Representatives looking for comments, as well as offering Q&A and postings as a video and Power Point Presentation on our website to be available.

- Look for sponsors to sponsor webinars! This goes back up to providing advertisement for a sponsor – If a company sponsors a webinar, we will recognize it at the beginning of the Webinar, and at the end. The business logo can be attached to all slides.
- Brown Act – Temporarily the Brown Act has been waived for the need to publish members of the Advisory Committees/Boards not needing to publish the address they are calling in from, It is CICA's goal to get this permanently for when this waiver expires.
- Fill sub-committee positions listed, minimum of three per committee (they do not need to be on CICA's Executive Committee but should at least have one Exec. Member as chair of the sub-committee).
